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

### Applying for a place in Reception

Children born between 1 September 2015 and 31 August 2016 are due to start Reception in September 2020. **The window for applying for a place in Reception opened on 14th November.**



Parents should have received information from Lincolnshire County Council about this. If your child is 4 between September 2020 and August 2021 then you need to apply for a place!

If you would like to come for a visit or know anybody who does then just make an appointment at the school office.

### Pupil Premium Funding

The Pupil Premium is a sum of money given to schools each year by the Government to improve the attainment of children who are eligible for Free School Meals. The school uses this money to ensure that children receive extra support and access to resources should they need it. The school reports each year on its website how the Pupil Premium Grant is spent.

**By checking to see if your child is eligible for the funding you are really helping the school to fund extra support, trips, visits and experiences for our children.** It also means your child may be eligible for Free School Meals when they enter Year 3.
