Whilst the sun starts to shine and the flowers start to show, next term is going to be a difficult term for many of us as we mark the anniversary of Mrs Overton's passing.

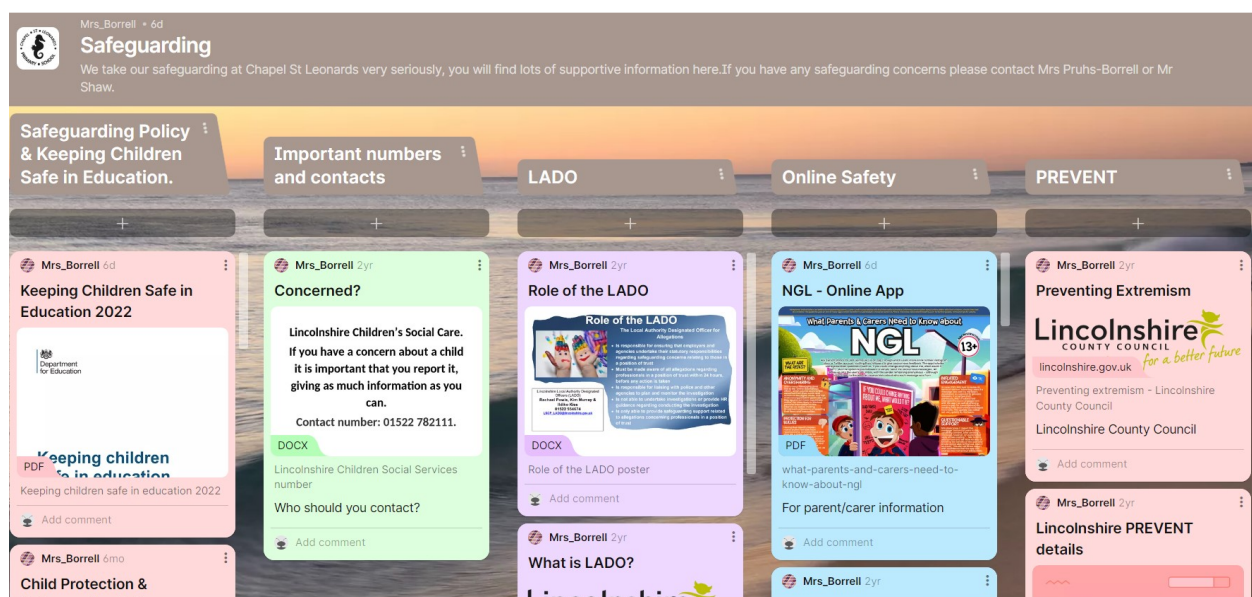
