**Computing**

In computing this term we will be using the internet safely to help us research different sea creatures. We will look at how ICT is used in the real world.

**English**

In our English work this term we will be reading lots of traditional tales and writing our own alternative versions of a very familiar story. We will write instructions using the features that are needed in this style of writing. We will develop our editing skills to improve our writing and look at punctuation that we can use to make our writing even more amazing.

**Maths**

Our maths work this term will focus on statistics and data and how these can be represented in different graphs and tables. We will learn about position and direction and the different vocabulary that needs to be used in this area of maths. We will learn how to tell the time to the nearest five minutes and how to measure capacity and temperature too!

**Science**

In our Science work for the summer term we will be investigating different habitats and the plants and animals that have adapted themselves to their home. We will look at habitats around the world as well as micro-habitats around the local area.

**Geography**

In Geography we will be looking at the coastline and the features that can be found around the U.K. We will make models of these features too. We will map out the coastline around us and contrast this with other coastlines around the country.

**Physical Education**

In PE Mr Borrell will be developing our athletic skills and we will also continue working on our bat and ball skills, using them in a range of games. PE sessions will be on a Monday and Friday and we will be using the most of the good weather by having as many of our P.E. sessions outside as possible.



**DT**

Our DT work will include making 3D models of different sea creatures. We will develop our sewing techniques by making puppets of animals we may find in the ocean.
