In school for 180 days = 10 days missed 95% attendance is the minimum target for all children

In school for 171 days = 19 days missed 90% attendance is a concern and we meet with all families and monitor this carefully as this = 4 weeks of school missed

In school for 161 days = 29 days missed 85% is a worrying attendance record with almost 6 weeks missed. We will now request you attend a meeting.

In school for 152 days = 38 days missed We will now require you to work with us to improve your child's tendance before we take further action including an attedance panel meeting. This may include Fixed Penaly fines.

#### **Times Table Rockstars**

The children in Year 1 to 6 all have a login for Times Table Rockstars. They can login at home on a laptop, mobile or tablet and complete times table questions. They earn coins for their correct answers which they can use to buy accessories and clothes for their online avatar. This is a really good, fun way for children learn their tables. The teachers can check to see which questions they are struggling on and can set the tables for them to focus on.

We will shortly be having some 'battles of the bands' where classes will compete against each

other to see who can complete the most questions over a period of time.
