

**Year4**

### **Activity 1**

#### **English**

2. Research how to scuba dive and write a set of instructions for a new diver.

### **Activity 2**

#### **Maths**

1. Write some real life problems linked to our theme – The Blue Abyss?
2. Create a maths game based on snakes and ladders including some of the creatures linked to our theme.

### **Activity 3**

#### **Topic**

1. Draw the view of the ocean you might see if looking through the window of a submersible.
2. Learn The Beatles' song, Yellow Submarine, and write a new verse of your own.
