# **Activity 1**

### **English**

Create a Remembrance Poem which is full of powerful, emotive language that allows the reader to connect with the past.

Remember: Look at different types of poems online and try different formats: rhyming couplets, narrative poem, haiku, etc.

### **Activity 2**

#### **Maths**

Create different graphs to demonstrate your mathematical ability but also things you do out of school.

Ideas: TT Rockstars progress over the term, home many steps you do each day/week, amount of rainfall in your garden each day, how many kick-ups you can do each day.

# **Activity 3**

#### **Theme**

To celebrate and pay our respects to soldiers in all wars, create a piece of artwork which shows poppies in a battlefield. Use the internet to inspire you.
