rear 381A In Year 3 & 4 this term we are studying Predators so have linked some exciting home learning for your child/ren to do by February 14th. We ask that adults at home try and do some of the activities with the children and question their choices to provoke enjoyment and curiosity with learning – this really can make a difference.

Activity 1

English

- Research and record a predator from each of the subgroups: mammals, birds, insects, arachnids, reptiles, fish and plants.

Maths

- You could write some reallife word problems linked to our Predator theme.
- Could you devise a maths game with a creative Predator title?

Theme

- If you could be a predator for the day, what kind of predator would you be, and why? Where would you live? What features would help you hunt, catch and kill your prey? Record your ideas on paper and bring them in to share with the class.
- Make a model of a predator.
