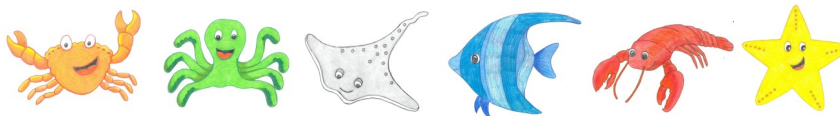
## SANTA FUN RUN

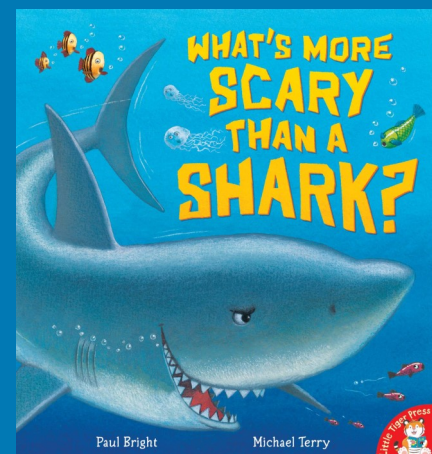
Due to the Reception Nativity, there won't be a whole school assembly on Friday 16th December.

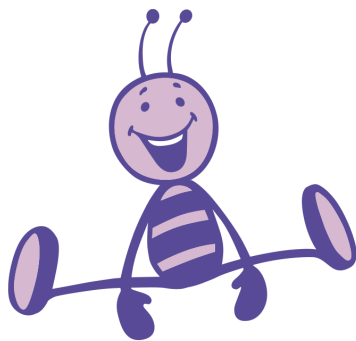
