## **Activity 1**

# **English**

Challenge: Create a border and illustrate your poem.

# **Activity 2**

#### **Maths**

Create a poster to show how many different ways you could make the 3-digit number – 254.

Remember that you can draw this as well as writing addition and subtraction questions.

### **Activity 3**

#### **Theme**

Design and create your very own Viking helmet or long boat. Could you write step-by-step instructions so that someone else could create one of their own?

Remember: Be resourceful! You don't need specialist items; recycle items from around your home!
