

In Year 1 this half term our topic is 'Beachcombing'. We have linked some exciting home learning for your child/ren to do by 24th May. We ask that some/all adults at home try and do some of the activities with the children. Please question their choices to provoke enjoyment and curiosity with learning, as we know this is beneficial and can really make a difference.

Activity 1

English:

- Make a list of activities that you could do at the seashore. Ask your family and friends what they enjoy doing
- Write a poem about things that may live in a rock pool

Activity 2

Maths:

- Find some objects to measure using nonstandard equipment (an object that is a consistent size – e.g. a hand span, footprint, a pen)
- Visit the beach and compare the weights of different object that you find

Activity 3

Theme

- Make a miniature seashore garden using natural materials such as pebbles, twigs, sand and shells.
- Make a 3D sea animal using any material that you like – e.g. play dough, Lego pieces, clay etc

General home learning

- Read your book every night for 20 minutes
- Practise your spellings
- Share your learning with someone at home
- Practice counting forwards and backwards from any number up to 100 and counting in 2s, 5s and 10s.
