



Trip: Chapel Beach and The Collection (Lincoln)

Geography

During our theme work we will study different Anglo-Saxon and Viking settlements.

English

This term we will be writing for a range of purposes, closely linked to our theme. We will be writing our own Myths and Legends stories, creating our own characters and describing different settings. We will also be writing our own historical recounts in the form of a newspaper. In addition to this, we will be exploring non-chronological reports and linking this to our new class pets!

It is vital that children read daily at home and school to further develop their vocabulary.

Maths

We will spend this term focusing on place value and the four operations. We will be developing fluency and extended our knowledge of being able to apply, reason and problem solve. In the first half term we will concentrate on place value, addition and subtraction and in the second half of the term we will concentrate on multiplication and division. Our times tables focus will be on learning 2, 5 and 10 times tables so that we can rapidly recall I both multiplication and division facts with increasing confidence.

Design and Technology

We will be designing, making and evaluating our own jewellery and clay rune stones. We will also be making models of Anglo Saxon homes. In addition to this we will create our own clay gods which we will learn how to fire in a kiln and use glazes to create different effects.

Physical Education

On a Monday we will be exploring different movements in gymnastics. On a Thursday we will be learning about and developing our skills in passing and receiving a variety of balls. Please ensure your child has their full PE kit in school all week. If they wear earrings and are unable to remove these themselves, please ensure these not worn on PE days.

Science

In science we are going to be carrying out a variety of investigations. We will focus on predictions, writing methodologies and recording results.

History

Our theme will be heavily history based. We will be exploring the Anglo-Saxon era and how they came to settle in the UK. We will then look at the Viking invasions and how they came to Britain.

Religious Education

Our RE lessons will explore Christianity beliefs from Anglo-Saxon times.

Music

We will be exploring different lyrics from songs describing life in Viking times, children will then compose their own songs over the term
