Year 3

We ask that adults at home try and do some of the activities with the children and question their choices to provoke enjoyment and curiosity with learning – this really can make a difference.

Activity 1

Challenge: Can you link your game to our Anglo Saxon/Viking theme?

Activity 3

Theme

Look at images of Anglo-Saxon artefacts; we have already looked at some together. Can you design an artefact of your own? You could draw a picture or use a range of materials to make your artefact – use your imagination!
