Activity 1

English

Could you do it on a computer? Create a booklet?

Activity 2

Maths

Create a range of word problems based on what we learnt last term.

Ideas: adding, subtracting, dividing, multiplying fractions, finding fractions of amounts, the 4 operations.

Swap them with a friend or bring them to me to solve.

Activity 3

Topic

Cook or bake a Mexican dish – it could be something that you have tried before or something new.

Bring pictures or samples to show us your learning.
