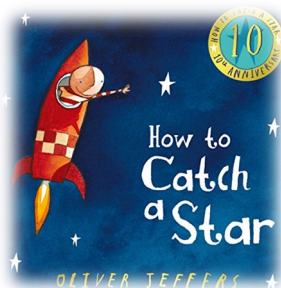
Parents Meetings
