Most embarrassing teaching moment: Showing someone round for a job and falling over—ooooppppss.

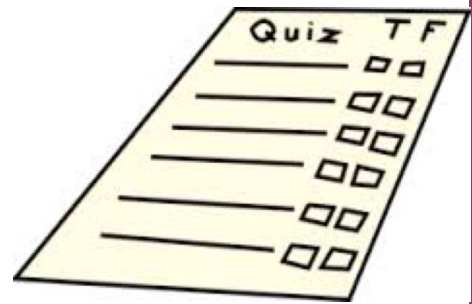


If you were an animal , what would you be and why?
